Answer option B is incorrect. Only charts are converted to the OLE objects, which can be edited. If you edit a chart in an earlier version of PowerPoint and then reopen it in Office PowerPoint 2010, it may appear differently.

Answer option C is incorrect. All the slide layouts that have user specific backgrounds and unique slide transitions are represented as multiple masters.

Answer option D is incorrect. The fonts of the heading and body are converted to static formatting. If the presentation is reopened in Office PowerPoint 2010 and uses a different style, the heading and body fonts do not automatically change.
