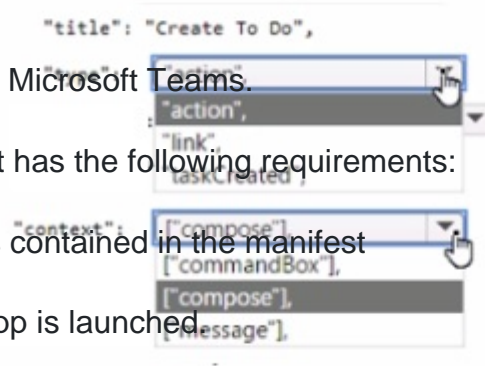
Question 6
